

Short and Long Sentences

It is best to write short sentences. You are less likely to make mistakes in them. The reader also will find the text easy to follow.

However, there are situations when a composite idea is better expressed through appropriate binding of its units through connectors and pauses marked with punctuation signs, the task of which is to assist the reader in interpretation. Therefore, you may consider using a well-knit long sentence, if you find that a series of short ones will fail to capture the matter so effectively, as you identify the entire idea as a single message to be communicated.
