1.	To note the announcement of establishment of IIT Rajasthan by MHRD, Govt. of India
-----------	-------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------

The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India had decided to set-up eight new Indian Institutes of Technology during the 11th Five Year Plan vide the Order No. F.No.11-10/2008-TS.I (Pt) dated 9th of May 2008 (**Annexure-1/AP 1**) and it had been further decided that the existing IITs shall mentor the New IITs for first 2-3 years or till these are properly set up. IIT Kanpur was assigned the task to mentor IIT Rajasthan.

However, the exact location of IIT in the state of Rajasthan is yet to be announced by the Government of India in consultation with the Government of Rajasthan. Till such time a temporary campus is being developed on the premises of IIT Kanpur with the spare resources available for providing various facilities to the first batch of students of IIT Rajasthan for the academic year 2008-09.

The Director welcomed the Members and gave an overview of the IIT Rajasthan activity and the mentoring by IIT Kanpur.

The Committee noted and recorded the order of MHRD appointing the Director of IIT Kanpur as the Acting Director for IIT Rajasthan and the Chairperson of the Board of Governor of IIT Kanpur as the Chairperson of Board of Governors of IIT Rajasthan till regular appointments are made.

2.	Formation of Coordination Committee, Academic Advisory Committee & Core Group
-----------	------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------

For the smooth functioning of the Academic and Administrative activities of IIT Rajasthan the following Committees/Groups were constituted with the membership various academic and non-academic staff members of the IIT Kanpur community : -

- A) Coordination Committee (**Annexure-2/AP 2**)
- B) Academic Advisory Committee (**Annexure-3/AP 3-6**)
- C) Core Group (**Annexure 4/AP 6**)

The Coordination Committee was constituted to oversee the overall functioning of the new Institute and pool the resources for the new Institute in coordination with the mentor IIT.

An Academic Committee was constituted to take various decisions related to the academic activities of IIT Rajasthan and formulate the academic policy of the Institute and discharge the functions equivalent to an Academic Senate.

A Core Group of Administrative Officials of IIT Kanpur was constituted to extend necessary administrative services.



The Committee noted and recorded that the Academic Advisory Committee is only for the current semester and the members appreciated the exemplary work done by the academic and administrative staff of IIT Kanpur and suggested that a suitable appreciation/compensation mechanism may be involved in consultations with the members. Further, a pool account is to be made for paying compensation for the additional work done by the Lab and other staff of Departments involved in teaching and lab sessions. Further, the entire information relating to IIT Rajasthan may be put on the website of IIT Kanpur and announcement in the IAC may be made and all the faculty members of IIT Kanpur may be informed about the mentoring of IIT Rajasthan by IIT Kanpur through appropriate channels.

The Committee felt the need for constitution of an Academic Senate for IIT Rajasthan.

3.	To note the data of students opted for IIT Rajasthan through Joint Entrance Examination Counseling.
-----------	------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------

The sanctioned strength of the students for the first academic year has been decided as 120 for three academic programs viz., Mechanical, Electrical and Computer Science Engineering with strength of 40 students each. Based on the counseling of the qualified candidates in JEE- 2008, (**Annexure-5/AP 7-12**) where their choices regarding the institutes and courses were sought, it has been found that all the GE, OBC and SC Seats have been allotted, while there is a vacancy of 8 seats in the ST category. The opening and closing ALL India Ranks (AIR) for the GE category are 1771 - 2666 for Computer Science and Engineering, 2392 - 3228 for Electrical Engineering and 2976 - 3646 for Mechanical Engineering. Out of total of 112 candidates offered seats in IIT Kanpur, only 12 are from the IIT Kanpur zone, thus a whopping 89.3% of the total candidates choosing IIT Rajasthan is from outside this zone. Finally, out of 112 students, who have been allotted seats at IIT Rajasthan, 8 are girls.

The Committee noted and recorded the above data & the information provided.



4. Information Brochure containing Orientation Program and Students' Registration Data.

To give an introduction about the mentor Institute, Help Desk, Documents, Fees required for Registration, Orientation Program and other facilities a Information Brochure was printed and distributed to the IIT Rajasthan students and parents (**Annexure-6/AP 13-22**). The Fees and other guidelines of admissions are similar to mentor Institute i.e IIT Kanpur.

The student registration data is enclosed as (**Annexure-7/AP 23-26**) along with the list of 109 registered students with their Roll Numbers.

A pre-medical examination was conducted for all the students seeking admission at IIT Rajasthan. A policy for compulsory Medical Insurance of all the students was arranged with the help of New India Assurance.

The Committee noted and recorded the measures taken in this regard.

5. Website and Temporary Symbol for IIT Rajasthan

The Web-site of IIT Rajasthan with its symbol is hosted in the IIT Kanpur's web-site (<http://www.iitk.ac.in/iitj/>) that gives information relating to Academics, Faculty, student Affairs etc. Various Circulars of Government of India, Administration, Contact details are placed on the web-site for the information of the students, parents and others concerned (**Annexure-8/AP 28**). A temporary symbol for IIT Rajasthan with the theme of Jantar Mantar, the Astronomical Observatory of Jaipur to commemorate the scientific knowledge of medieval India has been adopted for the use of the Institute till the final adoption of the Logo (**Annexure-9/AP 28-29**).

The Committee noted and recorded that the symbol appearing may be continued to be used till the official Logo of IIT Rajasthan is developed & approved by the Board of Governors in due course of time.

6. Formal Inauguration of IIT Rajasthan

The activities of the new IIT Rajasthan was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister of State for Human Resource Development, Government of India Smt. D. Purandeswari on August 2, 2008 at the Auditorium of the Institute in the gracious presence of Mr. Shriprakash Jaiswal, Hon'ble Minister of State for Home Affairs, Government of India, Mr. Kali Charan Saraf, Hon'ble Minister of Education, Government of Rajasthan. The Secretary MHRD and Principal Secretary Higher Education Government of Rajasthan also attended the inaugural ceremony. An invitation card of the event is annexed herewith for perusal (**Annexure-10/AP 30-32**). On the subsequent day the pioneer batch students were felicitated with institute's medal on account of Inaugural Day Celebrations.

The Committee noted the success of the event with appreciation.



7.	Status report of the activities of IIT Rajasthan submitted to MHRD

A detailed report regarding efforts made by the Mentor Institute for starting the academic programme of IIT Rajasthan was submitted to MHRD (**Annexure-11/AP 33-36**). The report contained several initiative like Lab, Library, Faculty, Lodging, Dining facilities for students was given in detail.

The Committee noted and recorded the status report sent to MHRD.

8.	Orders of MHRD on the Appointment of Acting Director for IIT Rajasthan & Chairperson of Board of Governors of IIT Kanpur as the Chairperson of Board of Governors of IIT Rajasthan

The Minister of Human Resource Development vide its order No F. No. 11-10/2008- TS.I dated 21st of July, 2008 (**Annexure-12/AP 37**) designated the Chairperson of the Board of Governors of mentoring IITs as the Chairperson of the Board of Governors of IIT Rajasthan and similarly designated Director of IIT Kanpur as the acting Director of IIT Rajasthan till a regular Chairperson, Board of Governors and Director are appointed.

The Committee noted and recorded the MHRD Order. Also it was noted that the, the Board of Governors of IIT Rajasthan is yet to be announced by MHRD, which may be formed after registration of the Society.

9.	Order of MHRD sanctioning the posts for IIT Rajasthan
-----------	--------------------------------------------------------------

The Minister of Human Resource Development vide its order No F. No. 22-19/2006- TS.I dated 1st of August, 2008 (attached herewith as Annexure-8) sanctioned Administrative and Faculty posts for the new IITs (**Annexure-13/AP 39**).

Presently, one post of Director (Rs 26,000 fixed), one post of Registrar (Rs 16,400-450-20900-500-22000), 15 posts of Professor (Rs. 18,400-500-22400), 30 posts of Associate Professor (Rs. 16,400-450-20000), 45 posts of Assistant Professor (Rs. 12000-420-18300) have been sanctioned, which are to be recruited over a period of next three years.

The Committee desired that a letter may be written to the MHRD stating that in IIT system the number of positions in terms of Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors is not mentioned except the total number of teaching posts so that the Institute will have the freedom to decide on the number of posts in each category.



10.	Release of Grants-in-aid under plan head to IIT Kanpur towards non-recurring expenditure in respect of IIT Rajasthan & opening of Bank Account.
------------	------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------

The Minister of Human Resource Development vide its order No F. No. 41-1/2008- TS.I dated 1st of August, 2008 (**Annexure-14/AP 40-41**) released a grants-in-Aid of Rs Two Crores Fifty Lacs Only to IIT Kanpur as the first installments for the New IIT Rajasthan. The Minister of Human Resource Development vide its order No F. No. 11-10/2008- TS.I dated 31st of July, 2008 (**Annexure-15/AP 42-43**) sanctioned opening of the Bank Account in favour of IIT Rajasthan.

Accordingly a Bank Account at Canara Bank, Kanpur in the name of IIT Kanpur to receive the funds from MHRD and another account with UBI, IIT Kanpur in the name of IIT Rajasthan for regular operation of funds have been opened, the Director and the Registrar of IIT Kanpur being the joint signatories.

An approximate amount Rs. 35,95,286.00 has been received towards collection of fees from the students registration including all kinds of fees.

The Committee suggested that IIT Kanpur may charge rent for extending various services like Administrative Office Building, Residential accommodation, Environment Science Building, any other service including electricity, water and other resources utilized by IIT Rajasthan. A suitable mechanism may be worked out to this extent.

11.	Academic arrangements, Course Structure and Honorarium structure for academic staff.
------------	---------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------

Subsequently to the formation of the academic committee the Honorarium structure was announced (**Annexure-16/AP 44-47**). The classes for IIT Rajasthan are being held at the newly constructed Centre for Environmental Science & Engineering (CESE Building) by acquiring three class rooms for organizing the lectures and tutorials. The Lab sessions are held in the Drawing and Design Lab of Mechanical Engineering and Core Laboratories of Physics and Chemistry Department of IIT Kanpur.

An academic calendar of the Institute and the time table cum course structure are attached for the perusal of the Committee as (**Annexure- 17 & 18/AP 48-49**), respectively.

The Committee noted and suggested that a suitable appreciation/compensation mechanism may be devised for other staff & Officers involved in IIT Rajasthan activities.

12.	Registration of the Society of IIT Rajasthan.
------------	------------------------------------------------------

The work of registration of IIT Rajasthan is under progress with the help of Government of Rajasthan and Ministry of HRD. It is contemplated that the

society registration can be held in Delhi as the location of IIT Rajasthan is yet to be announced by the Ministry of HRD.

The Committee was apprised that Principal Secretary Technical Education Rajasthan is taking necessary steps for registration of the Society.

13	Letter of Students' Gymkhana, IIT Kanpur offering cooperation to IIT Rajasthan students.
-----------	-------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------

The members were informed about the letter for Students' Gymkhana inviting the IIT Rajasthan students for the participation in Gymkhana activities (**Annexure-19/AP-50**).

The Committee while appreciating the gesture resolved that the IIT Rajasthan students would elect 1 president and 4 secretaries viz., (a) Science & Technology, (b) Cultural, (c) Sports and (d) Films & Festivals and would form a Student's Activity Committee which would coordinate with the Student Gymkhana of IIT Kanpur. Dr. Rajeev Gupta and Mr. KV Satya Murty would help students of IIT Rajasthan in this regard and coordinate with the Dean of Students Affairs, IIT Kanpur. A formal election be conducted for forming a Student's Activity Committee for IIT Rajasthan.

The Committee also issued guidelines that:

1. No IIT Kanpur official is authorized to make any policy statement about IIT Rajasthan except the Director IIT Kanpur/the Acting Director, IIT Rajasthan.

2. A suitable mechanism may be evolved for Merit-cum-means scholarship to be given to the students of IIT Rajasthan on top priority.

3. To keep the IIT Kanpur Community well informed about IIT Rajasthan progress through:

(A) Web site

(B) IAC

(C) Announcements in the Academic Senate, etc.

The Committee has recorded its appreciation for the cooperation and the best services being made available by all the Community members of IIT Kanpur including the Faculty, Students, Officers & Staff members in mentoring the new Institute.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

ORDER

Government has decided to set up 8 new Indian Institutes of Technology during the 11th Five Year Plan. In order to closely monitor as well as facilitate the work of establishment of these eight new IITs, it has been decided that the existing IITs will mentor the new IITs for first 2-3 years or till these are properly set up as per the details given below:-

Sl.No.	Mentor IITs (existing)	Mentored IITs (new)
1.	IIT Delhi	IIT Punjab

6.	IIT Bombay	IIT Indore & IIT Gujarat
7.	IIT Madras	IIT Andhra Pradesh

2. The Directors of the existing IITs will take all necessary steps and suitably guide the new IITs with a view to ensure that the new IITs are able to bring in the required standards as are expected of an IIT. Till such time as the full time Directors are appointed for the new IITs, the Directors of the existing IITs will take all necessary decisions for the mentored IIT/IITs as the case may be. As it is also proposed to start academic sessions by taking suitable premises on lease rental basis for 2/3 years till the permanent campuses are built for the new IITs, the Directors of the existing IITs should make all the necessary arrangements. Preferably the temporary premises should be in the same place where the site has been selected for the location of the new IIT. In some cases, where a temporary premises is not just available or the site has not been finalized, the first batch of students of the new IIT could be housed in the existing IIT itself. It would be desirable to have the first batch of about 40 students each, following the reservation rule (including 27% OBC reservation), in 3 & 4 engineering branches.

3. All the mentoring IIT Directors are requested to send a monthly Report starting from May, 2008, indicating the requirement of funds or any other areas where action is required at Government of India level. All the new IITs will have to be registered as societies and will be brought in the ambit of The Institutes of Technology Act through an amendment of the Act. Detailed instructions regarding the registering of IIT Societies etc. are being separately issued.


