Kar, **Head, Materials Science Programme by speed post**, failing which your admission offer will be withdrawn.

In addition, an amount in the range of **Rs. 3,500/-** will be required to be deposited (**in Cash**) as Mess Advance at the time of occupying the room in the concerned Hall of Residence and an amount of **Rs. 7,000/-** representing the various security deposits (refundable on leaving the programme) will be payable at the time of registration (by bank draft in favour of the **Registrar, IIT Kanpur**).

You are advised to report to the control room of the hostel preferably on **July 19, 2013**. - (c) Last date for late registration – **August 01, 2013** with a **late Registration fee of Rs.1000/-**

5 High School / Secondary School Certificate of the Board / University specifying the date of birth.

6 Three copies of passport size photographs.

7 A no objection certificate or a relieving certificate from your employer in case you are currently employed.

8 A cast certificate issued by a competent authority in case you belong to OBC(with non-creamy layer status), SC or ST community.

**Please note that the admission offer will stand cancelled, if**

- a) you fail to send acceptance letter and a bank draft for the full amount by the date indicated above, or
- b) you fail to attend the medical examination which will be conducted at Health Centre, IIT Kanpur, or
- c) you fail to produce any of the documents required to be presented at the time of registration, and/ or
- d) you fail to register by **August 01, 2013**, or

You may, however, on application, be allowed to produce documents mentioned at serial number 4) above by **September 30, 2013**, failing which your admission will stand cancelled.
