The party time began from Thursday evening, when the first cluster of alumni reached the campus. But the actual reunion started with a

He has been working on the new project and expected that the technology would be developed for commercial use by the middle of next year.

Talking to newsmen here on Friday, Dr Singh said that uninterrupted connectivity could be possible by using the satellite spectrum for the cellular phone spectrum.

He said the work on the new technology was taken up by his newly-formed MSV Company at USA. He said so far he has formed over 22 companies for developing new technologies and later sold the companies



is shareholder in seven of his companies in USA, Dr Singh said.

Dr Singh said that he and his wife Neera Singh, who is also an engineer from IIT-K. had first set up a company under the style. LCC International Company in the year 1982, which had 900 employees all over the world. Later, the company was sold and a new company was formed in the year 1991 to develop the technology of connecting the cellular switches.

He said it has been his venture to form new company to develop a new technology and then to sell the company and the technology. Consequently, 22 companies were sold till date, he added.

DR RAJINDER Singh was the first and the last student, who had stunned the authorities of the IIT-K by giving strike call in the year 1974. That was the maiden strike. After that no strike by the students was witnessed at the Institute.

This was disclosed by Dr Singh himself to the newsmen today. He said the cause of strike was quite petty. Since he had been the member of the student senate, one of the students complained against a security guard for thrashing him. The chairman of the board of governors Zahir Hussain, who was here on the day, called Dr Singh and assured to suspend all the erring guards. Consequently, the strike was called off within two days. However, Dr Singh said that he learnt a lesson from the strike that in future he would not venture to give such call as it involved serious tension.


