 - viii)Score card and admit card of GATE/NET/JRF/CSIR/JEST/Others (as the case may be);
 - ix) Sponsored, Part-time, and External students must upload a No-Objection Certificate from the employer. Others should upload a No-Objection Certificate or relieving certificate from the employer, if they were working at the time of application.

8. Students will be asked to sign an undertaking for the documents they cannot upload during registration. This undertaking will be available within the online portal. Admission of such students will be provisional until the submission of all the documents by March 15, 2021.
