## Shortlisting Criteria for MSR Admissions – 2025-26, Semester – I

(GN= General, OBC = Other Backward Class, OBC-NCL= OBC-Non Creamy Layer, SC = Scheduled Caste, ST= Scheduled Tribe, EWS= Economically Weaker Section, DAP = Differently Abled Persons)

Candidates are shortlisted for the MSR interviews based on the following criteria:

- 1. Candidates, who are BTech from IITs (applying without a valid GATE score)
  - a. should have an overall CPI (out of 10) above 6.5
  - b. last 2 years CPI (out of 10) should be above 8.0
- 2. All other candidates with BTech degree applying for full-time MSR
  - a. should have a CPI or normalized marks (out of 10) above the below threshold

- b. applying for CA, PE, RF, SPCOM or OPTEC stream, should have a valid GATE score, as per <a href="https://www.iitk.ac.in/ee/data/admissions/2025-26/Eligibility-Criteria.pdf">https://www.iitk.ac.in/ee/data/admissions/2025-26/Eligibility-Criteria.pdf</a>,
- applying for MVLSI should have a valid GATE score above the following threshold.

  - a. should have a CPI or normalized marks (out of 10) above the below threshold

b. The sponsoring organization must specifically undertake to provide full salary to the candidate and to relieve him/ her to pursue the program as specified in PG manual. The candidate must show a signed letter in this regard at the time of interview.
