Sonalde Desai is a demographer whose work deals primarily with social transformation and its impact on lives of individuals with a focus on education, employment, and maternal and child health. She leads the India Human Development Survey which is the only national panel survey in India. She is a frequent contributor to Indian newspapers and serves on the editorial board of Population and Development Review. Desai has recently been elected President of Population Association of America for 2022. She received her Ph.D. from Stanford University.
