

REGISTRATION

Auckland.

The technical part of the Conference was held in the University, whereas the Secretariat was located in the Student Union Building.

Wellington.

The Student Union Building of the Victoria University was fully put to use for the technical sessions, exhibits as well as the Secretariat.

At both venues the Secretariat had arranged for special counters to be erected with booths for: Bank, Registration, Government Tourist Office, Information and Post Office.

The New Zealand delegates were given the opportunity to register prior to the Conference, in both Auckland and Wellington. Registration of overseas delegates took place in Auckland on 22 January, 1965, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

After registration each participant received a box containing: a complete set of papers to be presented, invitations to various functions, an enamelled lapel badge - with emblem of "Ruamoko" -, name tags, programme of Conference, plastic satchel, etc.

A total of 421 delegates -representing 26 countries - registered for and attended the Conference. 163 Engineers and scientists arrived from overseas - 35 of whom were accompanied by their wives -, and 258 attended from New Zealand.

Each day, for the duration of the Conference, the Secretariat issued an "Order of the Day", containing items of interest to delegates. Up-to-date lists of names and addresses were also issued.
