earthquake engineering have long been developed in this country.

It is my sincere wish that thanks to the cooperation of all the participants the Conference will attain its objectives and will bring a valuable addition to the achievements in the study of the way to protect mankind from earthquake disasters. I hope especially that the participants from abroad will be able to become better acquainted on this occasion with the people of Japan, the way we live, our cultural traditions and so forth, and that they will join their Japanese colleagues in further developing earthquake engineering and in promoting international cooperation and understanding among scientists.
