ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Grade point average of 2.75 and above (on a 4.0 scale). Many international 3-year bachelor's degrees are accepted as equivalent to U.S. 4-year bachelor's degree.

English Language Scores (one of the following required):

• Minimum TOEFL score: Traditional: 550, IBT: 79

• Minimum IELTS score: 6.5

• Duolingo English test score: 120

Test Scores (may be waived under certain circumstances)

- GRE: 305 (verbal + quantitative scores), Quantitative score of 149, Verbal score of 142 for international students, or
- GMAT: 500 total, Quantitative score of 36, Verbal score of 17 for international students

HOW TO APPLY

Step 1 – Prequalification

Inform IITK that you are interested in this dual degree program. IITK will share relevant documents with UWM for evaluation.

Step 2 – UWM Formal Application

If prequalified, IITK students must complete UWM's online application, upload all required documents, and pay the UWM application fee. (Deadlines: July 15 for Fall Semester or December 1 for Spring Semester)

TUITION, FEES, SCHOLARSHIPS

IITK students will be charged UWM tuition and fees at the standard non-resident per credit hour rate, found at: **catalog.uwm.edu/admission-costs/tuition-fees/** (See Business Masters Fee Schedule).

The Lubar College of Business offers a \$6,500 scholarship paid over two semesters. To be eligible for the scholarship, the student may not be claimed by any recruitment agents, must pay the non-resident tuition rate, and remain in good academic standing.
