

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY KANPUR
and
AKASHI NATIONAL COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY

In accordance with our desire to promote international cooperation between India and Japan, the Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur, India, and Akashi National College of Technology, Japan, join in the following Memorandum of Understanding.

Article 1. Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur, and Akashi National College of Technology agree to cooperate in the fields of education, research and social services. To achieve these goals, the institutions will cooperate in the following activities:

1. Exchange of faculty members and researchers;
2. Exchange of students;
3. Joint research activities;
4. Exchange of academic materials, publications and other information;

Article 2. Matters pertaining to the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be negotiated and agreed upon between the institutions for each specific activity.

Article 3. This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into effect on the date of signature by the representatives of the institutions.


Article 4. This Memorandum of Understanding is subjected to revision by mutual consent of both institutions.

Article 5. This Memorandum of Understanding is subjected to termination at any time with six months' prior notice by either institution.
