## Memorandum of Understanding between

Geneva School of Business Administration University of Applied Science, Geneva, Switzerland

Computer Science and Engineering Department, Indian Institute of Technology (IIT-K), Kanpur, India

In accordance with a desire to promote cooperation in areas of mutual interest for the benefit of both institutions, the Geneva School of Business Administration (HEG), University of Applied Science of Western Switzerland, Geneva, Switzerland, and the Computer Science and Engineering Department, Indian Institute of Technology at Kanpur (IIT-K), India hereby enter into the following agreement:

- Geneva School of Business Administration and the Computer Science and Engineering Department of the Indian Institute of Technology at Kanpur, shall engage in cooperation in fields of common interest and shall develop joint projects in these fields.
- Joint activities will be established by mutual agreement of both parties. Both parties shall seek to engage in the following types of cooperation:
  - a) Exchange of faculty for research and/or teaching.
  - b) Joint research activities
  - c) Exchange of students for study purposes.
  - d) Other activities based on the agreement between the two institutions.
- The duration and the number of student exchanges will be determined by mutual consent. Such visits may be for one year or one semester.
- The two parties will designate individuals with responsibility for the coordination and implementation of this agreement.
- 5. Both parties agree to exercise their best efforts in securing funding for joint projects.
- 6. This agreement is effective for five years upon signing by both parties. Both parties shall review the status of the agreement at the end of each five-year period to determine any modifications that might be necessary. The period of validity of this agreement may be extended by mutual consent.
