MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

And
Kyungpook National University, Republic of Korea

This Memorandum of Understanding aims at promoting mutual exchange between Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur, India and Kyungpook National University, Korea through DST Unit on Nanosciences and Research Institute of Advanced Energy Technology respectively,

The two Institutes shall cooperate mutually to promote activities that can contribute to the development of both programs as following activities.

- (1) Mutual exchange of faculty members and students between two Institutes;
- (2) Exchange of publications;
- (3) Cooperative research on the environmental and energy issues;
- (4) Dissemination of current research outcomes and achievements;
- (5) Cooperation in information collection and exchange; and
- (6) Joint lectures and seminars.

Materialization of all the activities described in Provisions 1 through 6 may be made via mutual cooperation and discussion between the two Institutes.

This memorandum shall become valid after it is approved and signed by the appropriate authorities of both the Institutes. The memorandum shall hold good for a fixed duration of five years and may be renewed with written consent of both the Institutes. Each Institute may propose in writing any amendments in the agreement to the other Institute. The agreement may be terminated at any time prior to the date of expiration with three month written notice.
