MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Ulsan National Institute of Science and Technology, Korea And

Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur

This Memorandum of Understanding, made and entered into as of April 4, 00/3, by and between:

- 1. Ulsan National Institute of Science and Technology, Ulsan, Korea, hereinafter referred to as "UNIST."
- 2. Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur, India, hereinafter referred to as "IITK."

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as university and collectively as universities.

OBJECTIVES OF THIS CO-OPERATION

To continue to promote understanding and goodwill, to strengthen cultural ties, and to broaden student experience and horizons, UNIST and IITK propose to foster academic exchange and cooperation between the two universities.

NOW HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. AGREED MODES OF CO-OPERATION

The parties agree to explore the potential for co-operation in the following modes:

The two universities will encourage the following activities in particular:

- i) Exchange of faculty members and research scholars;
- ii) Exchange of students;
- iii) Joint research;
- iv) Exchange of information and available data.

1.1 Exchange of information and available data

UNIST and IITK agree to inform each other, to the discretion of the supplying University, about non confidential activities of their universities in the research, policy and programs areas of mutual interests (annual report, research schedule, profiles of activity of the universities, project information on selected activities).

1.2 Exchange of scientists, trainees and other personnel

UNIST and IITK will encourage the exchange of personnel to enlarge the knowledge of the Parties as far as they are able to do so. Such activities may include the exchange of both senior staff and junior trainees. UNIST and IITK will stipulate, through a separate written agreement, further details for the exchange of personnel and support each other by assisting with research accommodation, project and educational opportunities. There is no obligation on either host University to provide direct financial assistance to support exchanges of personnel, although each may assist to the extent possible in identifying possible financial resources to support exchange visits.

- 1.3 Other modes of co-operation can be agreed upon by the Universities.
- 1.4 This agreement shall not be construed to limit the liberty of either UNIST or IITK to undertake collaborations, projects, and further activities with other organizations, as each shall deem appropriate.



2. RESULTS OF ACTIVITIES AND PUBLICATIONS

- 2.1 The Universities intend that the results from their collaborative research activities will be freely published and shared broadly with the academic community.
- 2.2 Through the co-operation under this Letter of Intent shall only involve information that is published and in the public domain. Should any joint work be contemplated that deals with confidential information, a separate nondisclosure agreement will be negotiated between the Universities before any such work can begin.
- 2.3 Each University represents to the best of its knowledge and belief that it has not made or offered and that it will not make or offer with respect to the matters which are subject of this MOU, any payment, gift, whether directly or through intermediaries, to or for the use of any public official (i.e. any person holding a legislative, administrative or judicial office, including any person exercising a public function for a public agency, a public enterprise or a public international organisation).
- 2.4 Issues related to sharing of IPR developed during joint research or exchange program will be decided jointly by both Universities on a case-by-case basis to mutual satisfaction. A separate agreement will be entered into giving such details.

3. TERM AND TERMINATION

- 3-1. This Letter of Intent shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall remain valid for five (5) years. At the end of the term, this Memorandum is to automatically renew, provided that neither university gives written notification to the other university.
- 3-2. The Universities hereto shall endeavour to settle all disputes or differences that may arise out of the Agreement or in connection therewith, in an amicable way.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Universities hereto have each caused this Letter of Intent in duplicate to be executed by their duly authorized representatives as of the day and year first set forth above.
