Who are we?

- Established in 1967: More than 55 years old
- Providing education to under privileged children living in and around IIT Kanpur
- It came into existence as children of domestic helpers were not eligible to get admission to Kendriya Vidyalaya or Campus School
- Progressed from 6 students housed in a Type-2 quarter in 1967 to about 300 students in a beautiful new building now.
- Shri Harihar Prasad Singh building for Opportunity School is donated by Dr. Chandralekha Singh and was inaugurated on 2nd Feb 2020.

Present status

- ❖ The school has its own building; it runs classes from KG to VIII., recognized by the UP Board of Education.
- Generous donations from ALUMNI, especially Dr. Chandralekha Singh for the New School Building (Part-1).
- The school is run by a Management Committee, comprising of IIT Professors, School Principal, Principals of KV and Campus School, Representatives of Teachers and Parents and Special invitees.
- ❖ We are trying to go up to Stn. 10 as many children drop out of school after Stn. 8 because their parents are not prepared to send them to expensive schools outside the campus.
- ❖ 18 personnel: 1 Principal, 1 Coordinator, 10 teachers + 6 support staff
- Apart from academics, we help children acquire basic skill sets, confidence, healthy habits and an attitude to thrive independently.



Present status

- We also identify individual talent and provide opportunity to hone them by inviting specialized teachers for dance, art, jewelry making, quilling, mehndi application etc.
- Our students have also started acquiring skills in computer operations, an interactive Science Lab, and learning book craft, and home science.

Student facilities

- Minimum fees: Rs. 200-300 per child, p.m.
- Excellent new building with playground, garden, open spaces, laboratory spaces, well equipped class rooms, sufficient toilets, enclosed boundary wall
- Outdoor facilities such as Swings, Slides, Monkey bars.
- All students are provided with books and stationery, free of cost, every year.
- The school also provides a healthy mid-day snack every day to all the students.
- Uniform: Presently we do not have funds to provide, although we would like to take it up.

Future plans

(Academics)

- Upgrade the School up to High School. i.e., Std. 9 and 10 need to be started.
- Explore the change of affiliation to another education board (presently the School is affiliated to Uttar Pradesh Board).
- The two possible options are:
 - CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education)
 - BSB (Bharat Shiksha Board)
- New Board Affiliation will require several mandatory upgradations: in number of teachers, in teacher salaries, teacher qualifications, building infrastructure, peadagogic infrastructure, other safety and security measures



Future plans

(Infrastructure)

- ❖ Part-1 of the Main School building is already operational. This was constructed by a generous one-time full donation by IIT alumnus.
- Part-2 need to be constructed. The architectural plan is ready and approved. Space is already available.
- High School Science and Humanities Laboratories must be developed and made operational.
- Laboratory technicians (at least 2) will have to be hired.
- Sport and co-curricular activity infrastructure upgradation
- Modernization of pedagogic equipment/infrastructure (digital/modular/electronic/online/library)

1	New Building: Part II (New Building Part I is already operational)	INR 500 lacs	Required in parts for phase-wise construction: Phase-I : 100 lacs; Phase-II : 200 lacs; Phase III : 200 lacs.
2	Manpower (10 Senior Teachers) for three years	INR 100 lacs	INR 35 lacs is needed every year; minimum three years assured sum is required
3	Supporting Pedagogic Infrastructure (other than building)	INR 50 lacs	Overall upgradation of the present teaching and co-curricular facilities
4	High School Science Laboratory Development	INR 30 lacs	For upgradation to High School; mandatory requirements for board affiliation
5	Mid-Day Meal Supplement	INR 160 lacs (Corpus) OR INR 20 lacs	Corpus is desirable for ensuring sustained support. However, with INR 20 lacs, we can operate for three years without break.
6	Adopt a child	INR 60 lacs (Corpus) OR INR 10.0 lacs	Corpus is desirable for ensuring sustained support. However, with INR 10 lacs, we can support 10 students till HSSC education.




How to donate
