General Rules and Regulations – Swimming Pool

- 1. *Timings & Slots* All members and guests must strictly adhere to the pool timings and slots allotted to them on all days.
- 2. *Entry Procedure* Members will be permitted to enter the pool only after signing the register and handing over their membership card at the counter.
- 3. *Exit Procedure* At the end of their slot, members must sign the register again and collect their membership card.
- 4. *Children's Access* Children aged 3 to 12 years must be accompanied in the pool by one of the escorts listed in the membership application form.
- 5. *Attire* Proper swimming costumes/trunks are mandatory. Ladies and other members with long hair must wear bathing caps while swimming.
- 6. *Hygiene Before Entry* All members must take a shower followed by a footbath at the shower room entrance before entering the pool.
- 7. **Prohibited Substances** Application of oil before entering the pool is strictly prohibited.
- 8. **Soap Use** Use of soap in the swimming pool is strictly prohibited.
- 9. *Authority of Lifeguards* Instructions issued by the lifeguard(s) on duty are final and must be complied with at all times.
- 10. *Conduct in Pool* Playing, jumping, and quarrelling in the swimming pool are strictly prohibited.
- 11. **Prohibited Activities** Smoking, drinking, and consumption of eatables are strictly forbidden within the swimming pool premises.
- 12. *Photography* Photography within the swimming pool premises is not permitted without prior approval from the SPEC Chair.
- 13. Animals Animals are not allowed within the swimming pool premises.

Note: Non-compliance with any of the above rules will attract a penalty of ₹300 and may also result in cancellation of membership.

SPECIFIC RULES FOR THE BIG SWIMMING POOL

- 1. Maintain respectful behaviour towards fellow swimmers at all times; confrontations are strictly prohibited.
- 2. Diving, in any form, is not permitted during regular slots.
- 3. In the deep end, lanes 1–5 are reserved for male swimmers and lanes 6–8 for female swimmers during regular slots.
- 4. Swimming across the breadth of the pool in the deep end is not allowed.
- 5. Changing lanes while swimming in the deep end is prohibited.
- 6. Floating on your back in the deep end is not allowed, as it may cause collisions with approaching swimmers.
- 7. Crossing from the deep end to the shallow end without stopping at the rope separating the two areas is not permitted.
- 8. In the shallow end, swimming is allowed only along the breadth of the pool.
- 9. Underwater swimming is prohibited during regular slots.
- 10. Playful or disruptive activities are not permitted in the pool.
- 11. Tampering with swimming pool equipment or dressing room facilities is strictly forbidden.

Note: Non-compliance with any of the above rules will result in a penalty of ₹300 and may also lead to cancellation of membership.
