



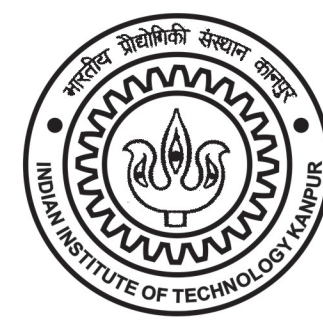
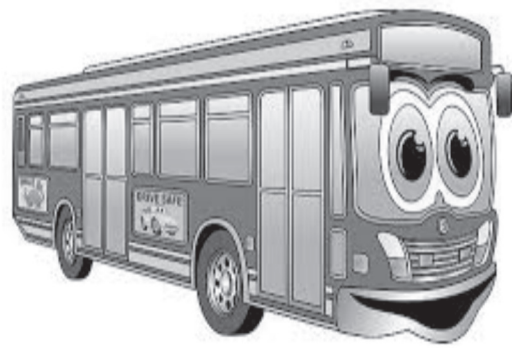
Sports Activities

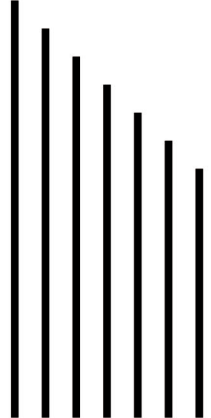
Fire extinguisher

Painting Competition

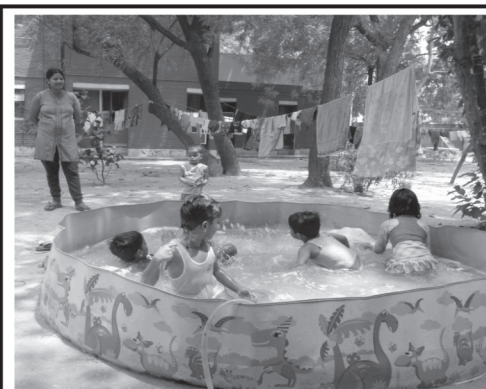
